LOCAL RULE 11

MOTIONS FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

- All Motions for Summary Judgment shall be accompanied by a Memorandum in Support of the motion and supporting affidavit or other documents permitted by Civ. R. 56. The movant shall attach to the motion, copies of all documents referred to in the motion or memorandum in support along with copies of the pages of transcripts of depositions of witnesses referred to in the memorandum. Any depositions cited in the memorandum must be filed no later than the filing date of the motion.
- 11.2 Responses to Summary Judgment and other dispositive motions shall be filed twenty-eight (28) days thereafter. Replies shall be filed fourteen (14) days thereafter.
- 11.3 A non-oral hearing date shall be set. If any party desires to have oral argument on the motion, a request for oral hearing shall be filed by the party within fourteen (14) days of the date of the supplemental briefing order.
